FEE: \$750 to be paid by cash or cheque to Lykander Chamber Music. Overtime is payable at a rate of \$200/hour. A \$50 deposit is due on signing contract to hold the date. \$700 balance is due by 3 October 2011.

SERVICE AND PERSONNEL: A string trio (violin, viola, cello) will be provided for seating and service. Aara will attend the wedding rehearsal on 9 Oct 2011. All players will attend the rehearsal with the singer at 9am on 10 Oct 2011.

TRANSPORTATION: The musicians will provide their own transportation to and from the event. \$40 mileage has been included in the fee.

ATTIRE: Attire will be elegant black.

EQUIPMENT: Musicians will provide stands and music. Wedding party will provide armless chairs and music for any special requests if necessary.

REPERTOIRE: Repertoire will include music chosen by the wedding party and musicians. Special requests should be requested well in advance, and, if necessary, paid for by the wedding party.

Fine print for events over 2 hours:

1. **BREAKS:** We need a ten minute break from playing every hour. For an extended event, we need a half hour every three hours.

This doesn't mean we have to leave the event. For example, if we're playing an hour-long wedding service, and get to sit quietly for ten minutes for a sermon, that counts. This break is largely ergonomic, to protect our hard-working tendons and muscles.
